

Management of Portfolio (M_o_P™) Foundation & Practitioner - 5 Day Course



Overview

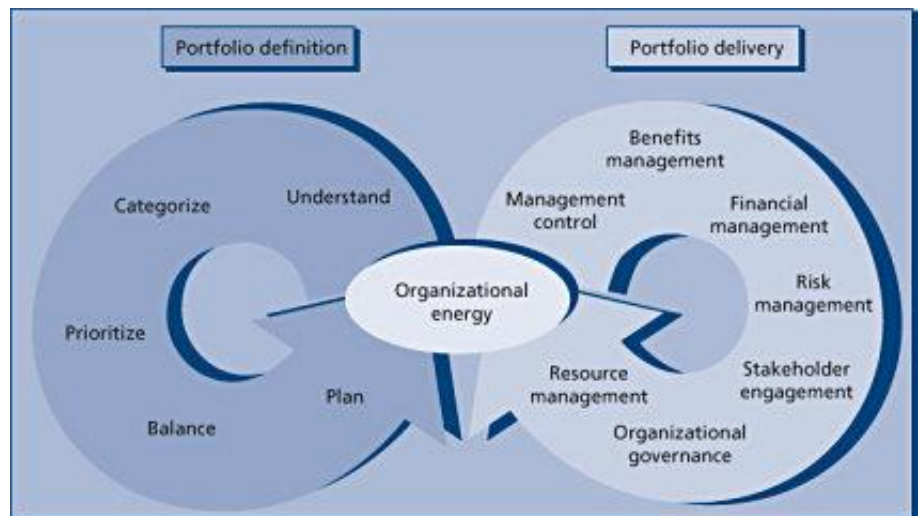
Portfolio Management helps organizations make decisions about implementing the right changes to business as usual; those changes are delivered via projects and programmes. It also provides a 'helicopter view' of all change activities, in both planning and delivery.

Rather than representing a new discipline, portfolio management seeks to build on, and better co-ordinate, existing processes such as strategic planning, investment appraisal and project and programme management. It approaches the management of change projects and programmes from a strategic viewpoint, focusing on the key issues.

Portfolio Management can be used effectively within specific directorates of the organization - for example, the 'IT portfolio'. However, the greatest success is realized when management boards use portfolio management to deliver the organization's corporate change portfolio as a whole.

Key Learning Points

The mechanisms by which these questions are answered are incorporated in the model shown below. This model brings together the key activities required to successfully define and deliver a portfolio of change whilst ensuring resources are used efficiently.
